NTA Declares JEE (Main) January-2020 NTA Score of B. Arch. and B Planning

The JEE (Main) Examination of B. Arch. and B Planning was conducted by NTA on 6th January 2020 in two shifts across 230 cities in the country and abroad. A total number of 138410 for B. Arch. and 59003 for B Planning candidates were registered in this examination. There were 345 examination centres across the country and abroad. 319 Observers, 213 City-Coordinators, 19 Regional Coordinators and 02 National Coordinators were deployed at these centres to oversee the smooth and fair conduct of examination. **The results of B.Arch. and B Planning have been declared today.**

1. **NTA Scores are normalised scores across multi session papers** and are based on the relative performance of all those who appeared for the examination in one session. The marks obtained are converted into a scale ranging from 100 to 0 for each session of examinees.
2. **The NTA Score indicates the percentage of candidates that have scored EQUAL TO OR BELOW** (same or lower raw scores) a **particular candidate in that session.**
3. **The NTA scores of a Candidate have been calculated as follows:**
$$\frac{100 \times \text{Number of candidates appeared in the 'Session' with raw score EQUAL TO OR LESS than the candidate}}{\text{Total number of the candidates appeared in the 'Session'}}$$
4. The NTA Score of the Total is **NOT** an aggregate or average of the NTA Score of individual subject.
5. **NTA score is not the same as percentage of marks obtained.**
6. NTA Scores of same subject but under different groups, like B. Arch and B Planning, may differ as number of candidates appeared in two groups are different.
7. Candidate's particulars including Category and Person with Disability (PwD) have been indicated as mentioned by the candidate in the online application form.
8. **After the JEE (Main) APRIL-2020 Exam , the Ranks of the candidates will be released taking into consideration better of the two NTA Scores of all candidates appeared in JAN 2020 and APRIL 2020 examinations and in accordance with the policy already made available on the website <https://jeemain.nta.nic.in>.**
9. The Examination was conducted completely in CBT mode.
10. In order to make the examination system transparent, the Question Paper and recorded responses were displayed in the website for the verification by examinees.
11. To ensure accuracy and transparency of result, the keys of question papers were displayed in advance to invite challenges by the candidates.
12. In nationwide competitive examinations, live CCTV Surveillance was carried out.
13. Jammers were installed at the examination centres to prevent unfair practice by the candidates during the examination through mobile or any other electronic device.
